



Here is a very short video which gives just a smidgeon of what we were able to do. With your help we were able to:

- Allot \$100 per pastor for four months
- Give each pastor a bag containing rice, beans, sugar, masa, oil, first aid kit, school supplies [which they give their church children], balloons, stickers, a soccer ball, and yes-fingernail polish for their wives, children and church kids!
- Provide a nice lunch for all of the pastors, including fresh pineapple and a chocolate cake, at a teaching gathering, along with \$ for their transportation
- Purchase a bicycle for a pastor whose bicycle (which is his only transportation to get to his church) had no brakes and tires that were threadbare AND we purchased a helmet for him.
- Upgrade a laptop for one of our critical VIM team members in Nica
- Gave gas money to the President of the Evangelical Methodist Church of Nicaragua
- Left emergency funds for the IGLEMEN churches [Evangelical Methodist Church of Nicaragua]
- Bless TWO new church plants with \$100 each to further their ministries and new congregations
- and much, much more

I will continue to update you and am available to visit your churches with info and opportunities to assist. We have begun a new church renovation at Hialeah for Pastor Henry and his wife and two children. I am traveling to Nicaragua August 21 for the final week of the build and appreciate your prayers and support. Stay tuned for updates on that project with pictures here and on my Facebook page. Also pray about the opportunity to go with me and email me for more information karintgunnell@gmail.com We are so blessed and these folks serve so faithfully with so few resources and are hungry for knowledge and the blessing it is to be METHODIST!

Participants will engage in a seven-month process that will result in:

- -A holistic understanding of their life and ministry.
- -A deep connection with other clergy colleagues who have the same desire to serve faithfully and effectively.
- -A personal development plan, which includes the steps they'd like to take to make incremental and significant improvement in the aspects of life and ministry that they've identified during the program.

The program is comprised of two retreats, one in the fall of 2023 and one in the spring of 2024, as well as monthly cohort meetings between the retreats to process their learnings and support each other throughout this journey. We offer three retreat cycles at three different sites: Pecometh Riverview Retreat Center, Manidokan Camp and Retreat Center, and Ocean City Waterfront Marriott. Successful completion of the Living Well program qualifies for 3.3 CEU's.


