In an average year, 123 Delawareans are killed, and 577 residents are wounded by guns. The Delaware Legislature has declared gun violence a community health epidemic.

Wear Orange originated on what would have been the 18th birthday of Hadiya Pendleton. Hadiya was an innocent bystander who was shot and killed on a playground in Chicago at the age of 15. Her friends commemorate her life by wearing orange, the color hunters wear to be visible.
