An electronic sign would play a significant role in one's first impression of Epworth United Methodist Church as one passes by the sign on Holland Glade Road. Any and all messaging that is placed on the sign shall be clear, easily read, and of high quality.

The types of messaging allowed to be displayed on the electronic sign includes:

- Ecumenical messages, scripture
- Announcements (events, activities, cancellations, instructions)
- Epworth Pre-School messages
- Boys and Girls Club messages
- Membership growth and marketing messages

The types of messaging that is prohibited to be displayed on the electronic sign includes:

- Political endorsements
- Commercial advertising

Any messaging not identified in this Epworth Electronic Sign Policy shall be approved by the Governing Board prior to being displayed on the electronic sign.

All messaging displayed on the electronic sign shall be approved by the Pastor Community and Communications.

The Epworth United Methodist Church Governing Board shall periodically review the use and resulting benefits of the electronic sign.

Epworth Digital Sign Process

- Office Manager (primarily planning/scheduling/review) and Pastor of Community & Communications (primarily content creation and review) in charge of all content creation/scheduling
 - \circ $\,$ We will create two weekly screen packages and modify them throughout the year $\,$
 - Monday-Thursday package will be different from Friday-Sunday package
 - We will plan a month in advance, correlating sign content with website/bulletin content
 - We will upload packages NLT a week in advance
 - \circ $\;$ Short-notice additions/deletions and corrections as necessary
- 30 seconds to 1 minute turnover per screen
- Run from 7 am to 9 pm (maybe 10 pm)
- Graphics as icons (typically blank/high-contrast colors)
- 3-5 words per line/4 lines of text (Arial Font), typically Title Cap (each word capitalized)
- Use cuts for all transitions
- Add Date/Time/Temperature (if possible)?
- We will not run filler screens (jokes and memes)

We will use the following screens/rotation plan:

 - a. 2-week advance for events/concerts
 - b. 4-week advance for tickets/reservations, Christmas Eve, Easter, VBS
 - c. Unique Day of Event screen
- 7. All rentals/events
 - a. 2-week advance
 - b. Unique Day of Event screen (Welcome/Congratulations)
- 8. Special Parking Instructions during Schell Village Days in December
- 9. Special Thank you's and Congratulations (church members, groups)
 - a. Featured Epworth Group each week/month
