
Mission u attendees will study the resurrection appearances of Jesus and the example of early Christian communities to explore what it means to practice hope in God even when things seem to be falling apart.

ADULT STUDY - *Practicing Hope* by Tabatha Holley

Practicing Hope is a biblical curriculum that explores hope particularly when hope seems hard to find, asking questions such as: How does Christ teach us to embody hope when our backs are against the wall? Attendees will find ways to allow all of our communities to cultivate hope that is honest about our current conditions (refugia), restorative when everything feels urgent (rest), and possible even when we experience despair.

Communities of the Spirit is a youth curriculum examining the hope we find in early post-resurrection Christian communities and how they kept hope alive in the most difficult times. National Historic Camp Meeting Celebration Scheduled for August 7, 2025

The Historic Camp Meeting Network [HCMN] announces a national celebration of the camp meeting movement on **Thursday, August 7, 2025, at 7:30 EDT (6:30 CDT)**. This collaborative worship service – the first of its kind – will be live-streamed to Camp Meetings across the country and feature the dynamic preaching of Bishop Gregory V. Palmer of the United Methodist Church.

“Our goal is not only to reflect on our rich legacy as camp meetings, but to use this heritage as a catalyst to inform and inspire all people to maximize their potential as children of God,” states Rev. Dr. Charlie Yoost of Lakeside Chautauqua in Ohio, who is coordinating the program. “We envision this event as a springboard to further collaboration among Camp Meetings across the United States, as we wrestle with common challenges and confidently look toward a future filled with hope and promise.”

The theme Scripture for the event is II Timothy 2:2: *“What you have heard from me through many witnesses entrust to faithful people who will be able to teach others as well.”* Camp Meetings across the country are invited to add this worship service to their 2025 summer schedule. Congregants should gather in a community space with the technology to view the livestream, or individuals may join via the link through the QR code. Camp Meetings should periodically check in via the QR code for updates on this program. A suggested gathering time of 7:15 PM EDT (6:15 PM CDT) provides individual communities with opportunities for fellowship and engagement prior to the livestream.

The service includes choirs from the Camp Meetings of Lakeside, Martha’s Vineyard [MA] and Ocean Grove [NJ], and will incorporate hymn singing led by the acclaimed 12,000 pipe organ from Ocean Grove. A historic portrayal of the nineteenth-century evangelist Amanda Berry Smith will highlight her visits to various camp meetings in the late 1800s.
